Stuart Rose Labour's Choice for Fareham

Stuart Rose has been selected as Fareham Labour Party's Prospective Parliamentary Candidate for the General Election in May 2015. A lifelong active member of The Labour Party he has previously been a Councillor on Fareham Borough Council and served as vice chairman of the Environmental Committee.

Passionate about tackling poverty and inequality, Stuart says "Britain cannot afford another term of Tory led politics of division between the very rich and the rest of us. All families in Fareham deserve decent, well-paid jobs to provide a good standard of income. We also need to tackle the cost of living – for example, the six largest energy companies have proved they cannot be trusted to act in people's best interest, so I support Labour's promise to freeze the price of energy to 2017."

To help the local economy, Stuart supports Labour's 'Free after Three' campaign which will give to car owners free parking in town centre car parks after 3 pm. Stuart will demand immediate action on new ideas and investment to stop the bottlenecks blighting our roads in Fareham. He will also demand the building of new affordable homes in our area. But Stuart says "We need to protect our local green spaces and not build on them, so I support the new development of Welborne."
