I am standing to be the Labour MP for Fareham because we need to combat the Tory led cuts and their unfair austerity programme.

I believe that the Labour Party is the only political force that has the welfare of the majority at its core and is the only party that will stand up for hard working families in Fareham. That's why we will ban zero-hours contracts which exploit low paid workers and make work pay by strengthening the Minimum Wage and providing tax breaks to firms that boost pay through the Living Wage.

A key issue for people in Fareham is coping with the increased cost of living as wages stagnate and help for families such as tax credits is reduced. With cuts to public services making life difficult for many people in our community, it is clear that we must elect a Labour Government to deal with these issues fairly.

Locally I have been delighted to play a role in Labour's campaigns such as '20 is plenty', a Hampshire wide Oyster type transport card, 'free after three' and the protection of Sure Start places. All of these have at their root a benefit for the many not the few.

Under David Cameron it's getting harder to see a GP and waiting lists are going up.



Labour's plan:

- ✓ 8,000 more doctors, 20,000 more nurses, 5,000 more home-care workers and 3,000 more midwives
- ✓ Funded by clamping down on tax avoidance, and by raising tax on tobacco companies and properties worth more than £2 million
- ✓ Guaranteed GP appointment within 48 hours, or on the same day for those who need it

Labour will increase free childcare

More help with childcare is good for family life and good for the economy. We know parents would like to work, but childcare makes it unaffordable.

To help hard working families Labour will expand free childcare from 15 to 25 hours per week for parents of three and four year-olds. Labour will also introduce a legal guarantee of access to wraparound care from 8am to 6pm through their local school. We will restore early intervention at the heart of our approach to supporting children and their parents, with Sure Start playing a key role.

LABOUR WILL:

- Extend free childcare from 15 to 25 hours for working parents by an increase in the bank levy.
- Introduce a legal guarantee that parents of primary-aged children will have access to care from 8am to 6pm.
- Reinvigorate Sure Start, reforming the way local services work.
